The AIM Challenge

- Complete the Challenge tasks over the course of this academic year, submit to your subject teacher and you will achieve the AIM programme award in this subject.

Term	Challenge Task Title	Task Description
Term 1	Wider reading task to complement the ' <i>Sherlock Holmes</i> ' unit.	Read Conan Doyle's novel 'The Hound of the Baskervilles'. Consider the importance and purpose of the manuscript. Create your own authentic looking manuscript with a page explaining its purpose to the novel as a whole.
Term 2	Creative writing task to complement the ' <i>An Inspector Calls</i> ' unit.	Script one of the missing scenes that include Eva, keeping closely to Priestley's style.
Term 3	Research and comparison task to complement the 'Shakespeare' unit (Over two terms)	Research the tragedy genre and make a fact file. Then watch and read another of Shakespeare's tragedies, not studied in class, and make comparisons between the main characters in your class play and your own choice. Present your ideas in an essay.
Term 4	Research and comparison task to complement the 'Shakespeare' unit - continued	As above.
Term 5	Research and essay task to complement the ' <i>Of Mice and Men</i> ' unit	Research American History of the 1920s and 1930s; In what ways were writers at this time influenced by the world around them? Write an essay.
Term 6	Creative task to Complement the 'Growing Up' unit	Create a Vlog of your experiences of Key Stage three and of growing up generally.
