Item: How to add certificates

Step 1 –

Please note if any of you are using your personal devices on the school network (School devices already have this configured automatically) you may notice recently that you're having issues accessing Google and YouTube after they've implemented some changes to their servers.

You'll need to add an additional security certificate to your device to resolve this and access these while on our network, please see the below instructions for Windows machines (You'll have to have a look at how to do this for other operating systems – "Import SSL certificate")

Please note this certificate is provided by a third-party (Our ISP) and as such please be aware any issues this may cause are out of our control, therefore only proceed if you accept this notice.

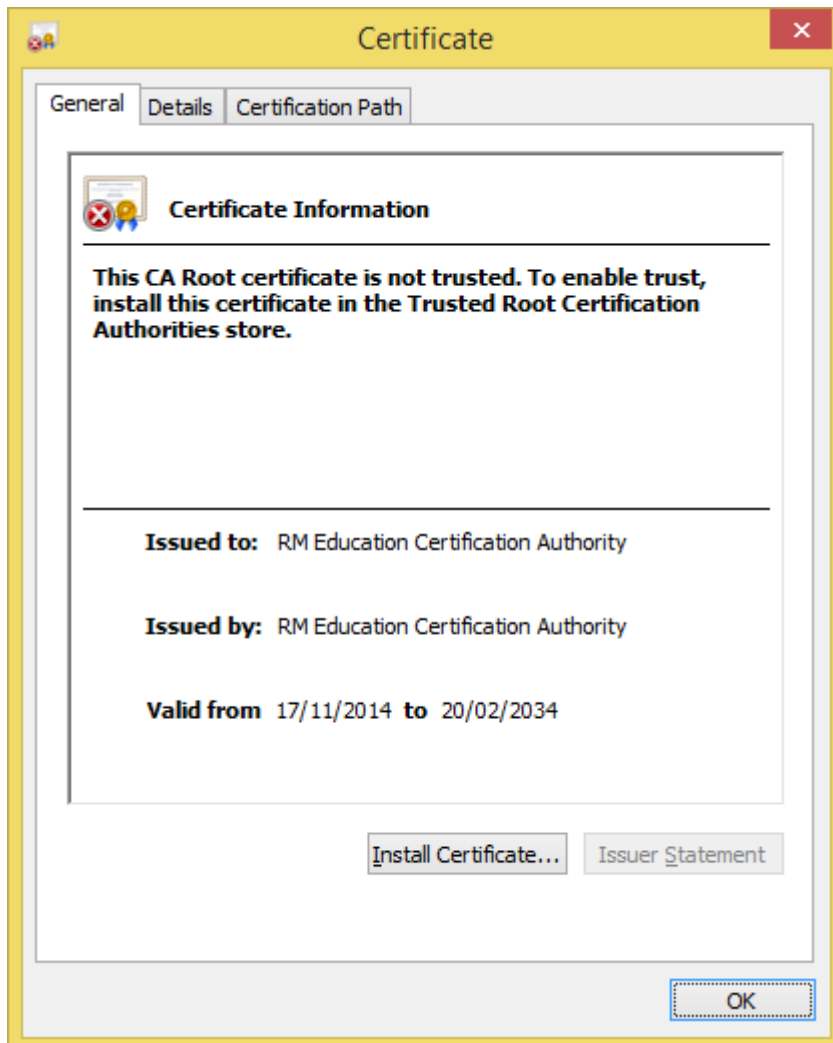

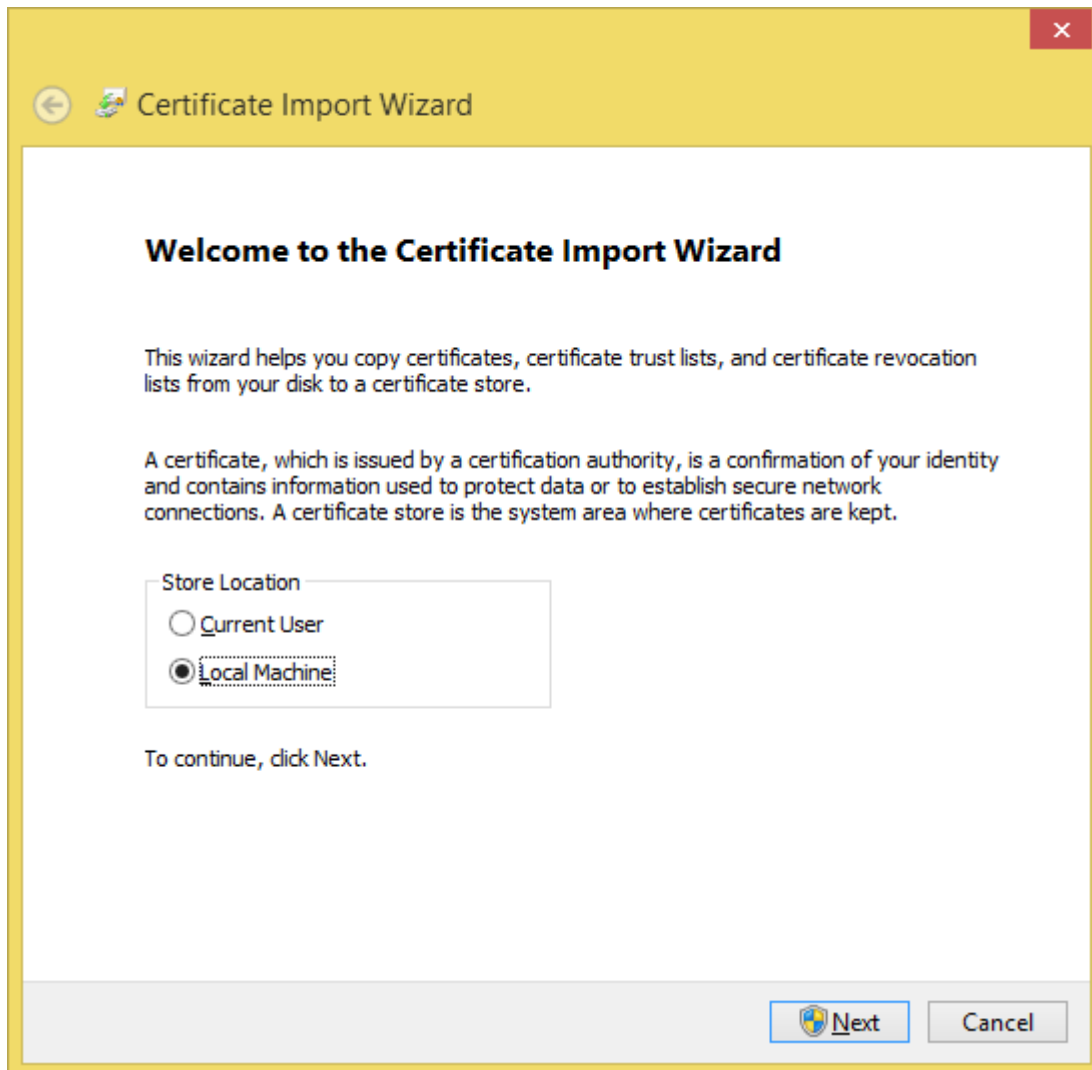


Step 3 –

Click “Install Certificate”



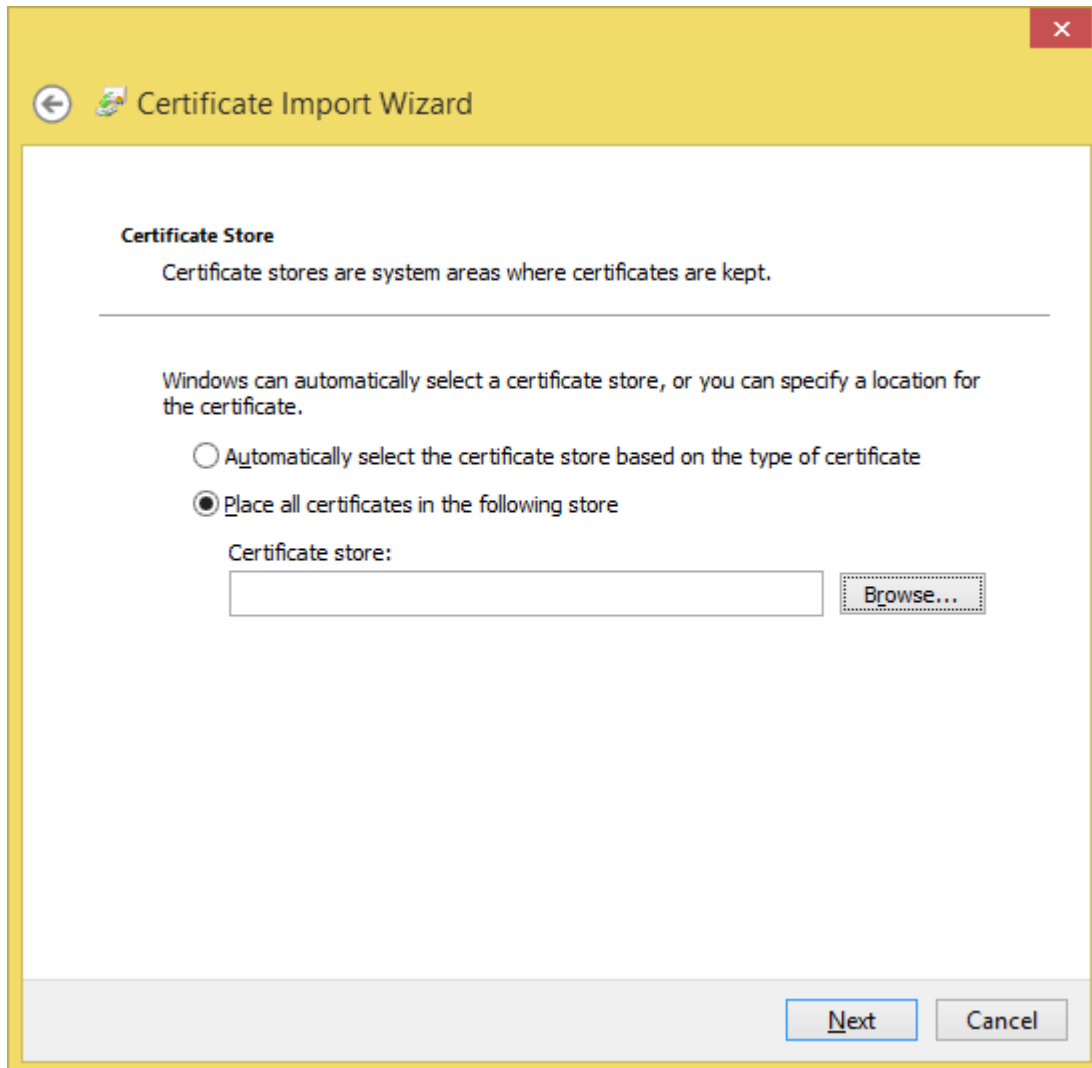
Step 4 –
Select “Local Machine”





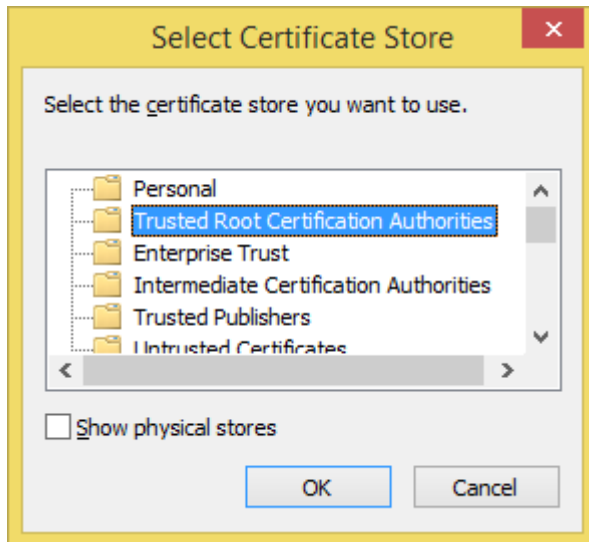
Step 5 –

Select “Place all Certificates in the following Store” and click Browse



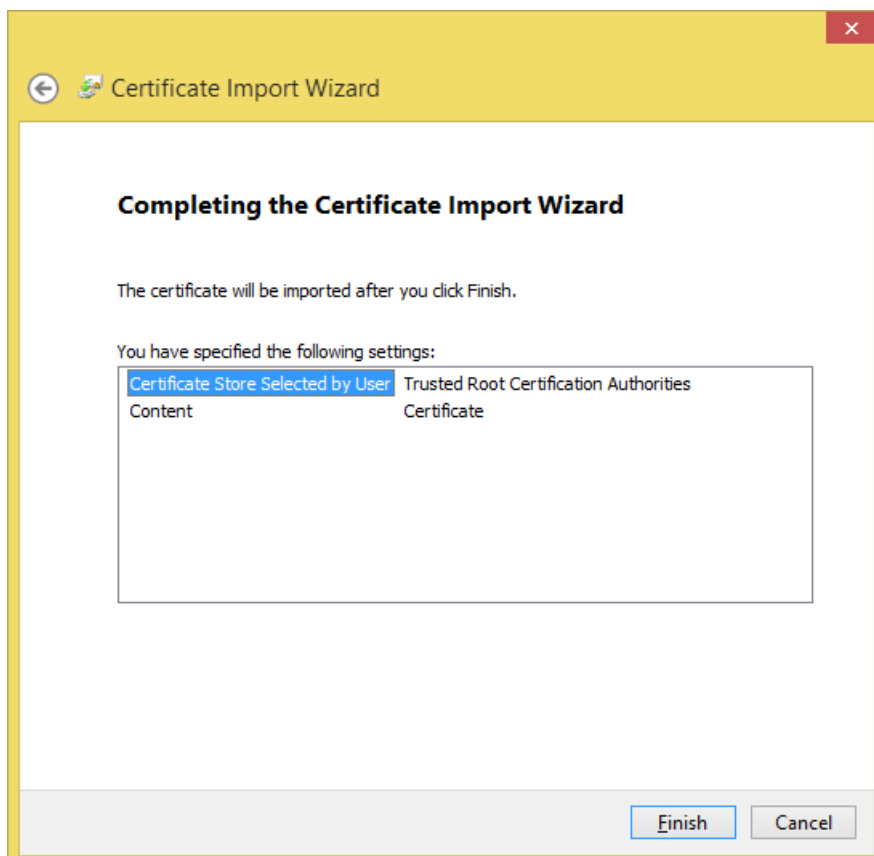
Step 6 –
