



Distance Learning during School Closure – KS4



In the event of school being closed, you should complete work set by your teacher on Show my Homework.

Outlined below is additional work or methods of study that you could use in order to recap and revise content already taught to you this year or to help you understand new content being delivered via distance learning

- Use GCSE Pod. There are lots of revision videos for you to stream and complete quizzes that accompany them. Go to www.gcsepod.com – you all have a log in. Please email your tutor if you need a password reset. Both Year 10 and 11 are set up on GCSE Pod.
- Create a key vocabulary list for your subjects. List out key terms covered and define them. – You could do these as flash cards and test yourself!
- Create revision mind maps using online revision resources about topics that you have covered.
- Work on target areas from previous assessments – use revision guides and online resources to revise areas that you have struggled with on previous assessments. Then test yourself using online quizzes.
- Write a quiz or a test for your class. Come up with 10 questions, with answers and then circulate these amongst your class or friends.

- Especially for Year 11, go onto your exam board websites and complete practice paper questions. Email these to your teacher.
- Complete some wider reading – what is your favourite subject? Ask your teacher to recommend a book you could read to extend your knowledge in this area.
