



Distance Learning during School Closure – KS5



In the event of school being closed, you should complete work set by your teacher on Show my Homework.

Outlined below is additional work or methods of study that you could use in order to recap and revise content already taught to you this year or to help you understand new content being delivered via distance learning

- Use a textbook to consolidate work you have already covered. Add additional detail to class notes.
- Make revision notes such as mind maps, using a revision checklist to help.
- Wider reading. If you have a reading from your teacher select a book from here and write a summary of the article in no more than 300 words. If you don't have reading list, ask your teacher for some suggestions.
- Create a key terms glossary for each subject. Add new keywords as you go.
- Work through practice exam questions. This may have been given to you or you can go onto exam board websites to access.
- Ensure that your folder is in order and you have created revision notes for each topic using the syllabus check lists.
- Follow on Twitter or Social media a journalist or blogger in your subject area then summarise an article each week.
- Read other texts related to the ones you are studying e.g. novels, plays and poetry written in the same period or by the same author.
- Create a quiz for others to do! Write questions and then share them to the rest of the class via email.
